Welcome to Price City, the county seat of Carbon County, located in southeastern Utah.

Price City is home to 8,715 people, but serves as the business, shopping and entertainment hub for the 32,379 residents of Carbon and Emery Counties.

Price is also a popular food and fuel stop for travelers enjoying the scenic attractions of southeastern Utah, including the USU Eastern Prehistoric Museum, Scofield Reservoir, Cleveland Lloyd Dinosaur Quarry, Canyonlands National Park, Arches National Park, Lake Powell and many others.

The Price City Police Department employs 17 sworn officers, one ordinance compliance officer, two police secretaries and one victim advocate.

We provide full-time law enforcement services. Eight officers and two sergeants are assigned to patrol. One officer and one secretary are assigned to the Carbon Metro Drug Task Force, two officers and a sergeant to investigations and one officer is assigned as a school resource officer. The department administration consists of the Chief of Police and a Police Captain.

Our department is dedicated to serving our citizens and guests in the most professional manner possible. The department members are part of the community and strive to make Price a safe community where citizens are comfortable raising their families.
