1. Mayor Kourianos called the regular meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. Pastor David Alvarez with the Trinity Christian Center offered a word.
2. Mayor Kourianos led the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Roll was called with the above Councilmembers and staff in attendance. Councilmembers Marsing was excused/absent.
4. SAFETY SECONDS – Councilmember Davis noted that we are now on Daylight Savings Time. He reminded everyone to check/change the batteries in their smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors.
5. PUBLIC COMMENT – No public comment was received on any item.
6. CARBON COUNTY MINISTER'S ALLIANCE - Request for sponsorship.
Pastor David Alvarez with the Carbon County Minister’s Alliance addressed the Mayor and Council. The alliance requested the use of the auditorium on April 10, 2020 to host the Good Friday Workshop Gathering. He also asked for consideration in waving the rental fees.
MOTION. Councilmember Miller moved to approve the use of the auditorium and waive the rental fees. Motion seconded by Councilmember Knott-Jespersen and carried.
7. SAFETY SECONDS CHALLENGE RECOGNITION - Recognition of Tina Rowley and Sky Jensen as the Safety Seconds Challenge Winners. Sky nominated Tina (each gets recognized) for providing a safety message about correct lifting technique and dealing with aggressive people.
Nick Tatton reviewed the Safety Seconds Challenge. The Mayor and Council recognized Tina Rowley and Sky Jensen and thanked them for working safely.
8. STREET NAME CHANGE - Consideration and possible approval of changing the street known as 100 North to University Boulevard 100 North.
A discussion was held on adding an addition to the name of 100 North. No address changes are required at the post office. The updated name of the street is University Boulevard 100 North.
MOTION. Councilmember Miller moved to approve adding the name of University Boulevard to 100 North from Exit 240 to 300 East. Motion seconded by Councilmember Davis and carried.
