

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – PRICE CITY CULINARY WATER RATE INCREASES

Price City will be holding a public hearing on April 9, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at 185 East Main Street, to review and evaluate proposed increases for its culinary (drinking) water rates charged to its customers. To ensure the continued reliability and quality of its drinking water supply, the City is implementing water rate increases to fund essential upgrades to some of the City's aging water infrastructure, including its spring water transmission line and water treatment plant. It is anticipated that there will be a series of rate increases implemented over the next three years, with the current year increase taking effect on May 1, 2025. Based upon the proposed first year rate changes, the current average monthly residential water bill is estimated to increase from \$32.76 to \$47.01 and the current average commercial/institutional water bill is estimated to increase from \$99.30 to \$137.26.
