

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Price City will hold a public hearing to review and evaluate a proposed Spring Water Transmission Line Replacement Project. The project is needed to ensure the continued delivery of safe, clean drinking water from the City's Colton Springs to the City's water treatment plant and distribution system. Most of the existing seven-mile section of the transmission line to be replaced is 95 years old and is beyond its useful life. An extensive study of the condition of the transmission line was completed in February 2024 which documented the poor condition of the aging infrastructure. Price City will be seeking funding assistance for the design and construction phases of the project from multiple sources, including grant/loan funding through the State Division of Drinking Water, as well as grant/loan funding through the Permanent Community Impact Board (CIB). The public hearing will be held on Wednesday, April 9, 2025 at 5:00 pm in the City Council Chambers at 185 East Main Street. For additional information contact Miles Nelson at 637-5010.
