MINUTES OF PRICE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The Price City Council meeting convened in regular session on Wednesday, April 10, 2019, in the Price City Hall Council Chambers, Room 104, and meeting commenced at 5:51 P.M.

MOTION. Councilmember Davis moved to open the second CDBG public hearing at 5:51 p.m. Motion seconded by Councilmember Knott-Jespersen and carried.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor pro tempore Miller opened the second public hearing for the CDBG program. Mayor pro tempore Miller stated that this hearing was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project that was awarded under the 2019 Community Development Block Grant Program. The city has amended its capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds on behalf of the ADA Access to Price City Library Basement located at 186 East Main, Price, Utah. The Mayor pro tempore introduced Norma Procarione, Project Manager, from the ADA Access to Price City Library Basement project. The Mayor pro tempore explained that the application was successful in the regional rating and ranking process and ADA Access to Price City Library Basement in the amount of \$37,880. The Mayor pro tempore explained the project to those in attendance. The Mayor pro tempore then asked for any comments and concerns from the audience. Darrelyn Davis addressed the Mayor pro tempore and Council. Her son uses the library and requires ADA access. She requested information on the status of the grant. Jade Powell, SEUALG Program Manager, reviewed the grant process. Bret Cammans, Price City Customer Service Director, reviewed the project details. Dee Davis addressed the Mayor pro tempore and Council. They use the library to entice his disabled son to come out of the house. It is important to him that the library is ADA accessible. The Mayor pro tempore stated that copies of the capital investment plan are available if anyone would like a copy. There were no more comments and the hearing was adjourned at 6:05 pm.

Mayor pro tempore Miller called for a motion to close the public hearing.
