1. Mayor Kourianos called the regular meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. Mayor Kourianos led the Pledge of Allegiance. Pastor Jimmy Darter with Liberty Faith Fellowship offered a word.
3. Roll was called with the above Councilmembers and staff in attendance. Councilmember Knott-Jespersen was excused.
4. SAFETY SECONDS – Councilmember Willis reviewed hot weather safety tips.
5. WATER CONSERVATION UPDATE -  
Miles Nelson reviewed the water conservation information update provided:  
Water Resources Update as of July 12, 2021:
  - As of July 11, 2021, Scofield Reservoir had a water content of 25,648 Acre Feet (39% capacity).
  - Precipitation Accumulation (October 1, 2020 – July 12, 2021) = 12.5” (55% of average).Residential water usage is down 30%. The public responsive has been very effective and appreciated.
6. PUBLIC COMMENT – No public comment was received on any item.
7. RENTAL FEE WAIVER REQUEST - Megan Cumming from United Way of Eastern Utah will request a fee waiver for Washington Park rental on 9-11-21 for United Way Day of Caring.  
Megan Cumming with United Way of Eastern Utah addressed the Mayor and Council. She stated the Day of Caring is scheduled for Saturday, September 11, 2021. She would like to utilize the Washington Park Pavilion on that day from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM for lunch for the volunteers.
