Mayor Piccolo called the meeting to order at 12:05 p.m. Roll was called with the above Councilmembers and staff in attendance.

1. HOT AIR BALLOON RIDES- Consideration and possible approval of a contract for hot air balloon services to be provided at International Days

Kendra Seeley of the Centennial Celebration Committee stated that she was able to contact the owner of Hot Air Enterprises, LLC. that will be providing the hot air balloon rides for International Days. She stated that he sent letters and information to answer the questions that the City Council had at the July 13, 2011 meeting. She provided the Mayor and Council with a copy of the insurance company's agreement to add Price City to their insurance policy at zero dollar aggregate with a premium cost of \$41.20 which the City will be responsible for at the time of payment. Councilmember McEvoy stated that she had contacted a personal balloon pilot/friend and found that a license and own insurance is necessary for a company to provide hot air balloon rides and believes that this balloonist is qualified and will do a good job based on his contract. Mrs. Seeley stated that the owner will have an FFA flight report for that day. She stated that the five volunteers for Friday morning will come from the Carbon County Recreation and Saturday's volunteers will be from the volunteer fire department. There is a list of volunteers available for the Mayor and Council to preview and the owner will meet with all volunteers on Thursday for training. She stated that waivers will be given to all volunteers before the event from the owner and waivers for the riders will be given right before each balloon ride. **MOTION.** Councilmember Hanna-Smith moved to approve the contract with Hot Air Enterprises, LLC. and the information provided by the owner regarding the insurance and volunteers. Motion seconded by Councilmember Nielson. Councilmember McEvoy voted nay. Motion passed four (4) to one (1).

2. TIRE BURNOUT BARRICADES- Consideration and possible approval of contracting out the set up and removal of barricades for the tire burnout at International Days.

Mayor Piccolo stated that Tori Killian would manage the burn out event that is to be held at International Days. He stated that barricades are going to be necessary to keep the event contained and to keep spectators away from the area. Councilmember Tatton stated that Gary Sonntag recommended 50 barricades and 40 feet between the event and the spectators. Mayor Piccolo stated that there would be approximately fifty feet of space for the cars to burn out at 20 miles per hour in 30 seconds. He stated that he would contact Tori Killian to get all of the specifics regarding the participants, barricade cost and use of sound system from Price City. The barricades will be contracted out through a local company that has enough barricades and the manpower to set them up and take them down. **MOTION.** Councilmember Tatton moved to authorize the Mayor to work with Tori Killian and contract services for the barricades for the tire burnout activity at International Days with a cost for the services up to \$1000. Motion seconded by Councilmember Hanna-Smith and carried.

The regular City Council meeting adjourned at 12:46 p.m. by Mayor Piccolo pursuant to the motion by Councilmember Hanna-Smith.
