**EMERGENCY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
PUBLIC HEARING:**

Mayor Kourianos opened the second public hearing for the CDBG program. Mayor Kourianos stated that this hearing was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project that was awarded under the 2023 Community Development Block Grant Program. Price City has amended its capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds on behalf of the Price City Fire Department located at 87 N 200 E Price, UT 84501. The Mayor introduced Chief Fitz Petersen from the Price City Fire Departments SCBA'S. The Mayor explained that the request for the emergency funding application was successful and awarded to Price City Fire Department SCBA'S in the amount of \$150,000.00. The Mayor explained the project to those in attendance. The Mayor then asked for any comments, questions and concerns from the audience by first stating their name and then for their questions or comments. Seeing none, the Mayor asked to adjourn the meeting. The Mayor stated that copies of the capital investment plan are available if anyone would like a copy. There were no more comments and the hearing was closed at 5:03 PM.
