8. LIBRARY BASEMENT RAMP PROJECT - Consideration and possible approval to sign the CDBG Grant Contract for the Library Basement Ramp Project. This contract will provide \$37,889 towards the project.
9. 100 NORTH/CARBON AVENUE SIGNAL REPAIR - Consideration and possible approval of repair of signal light by Oak Hollow Electric Company for \$8,377. Signal is owned by UDOT and damaged by Price City during water leak repair. Oak Hollow is one of only three contractors approved by UDOT for this type of work. All three were solicited and Oak Hollow is the lowest price.
10. BUSINESS LICENSES - Consideration and possible approval of business licenses for: Cydney Lehr at 790 N Cedar Hills Dr. and Nikki Kaye Sillitoe at 35 N 300 E.
