1. Mayor Kourianos called the regular meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Pastor Rebecca Aardahl with Ascension St. Matthews Church offered a word.
2. Mayor Kourianos led the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Roll was called with the above Councilmembers and staff in attendance. Councilmember Knott-Jespersen and Councilmember Marsing were excused.
4. SAFETY SECONDS – Councilmember Willis noted that it is getting dark outside earlier. A lot of kids are outside running around. Also, it will be Halloween soon. She encouraged everyone to pay attention while driving on the dark streets and watch out for the kids and pedestrians
5. WATER CONSERVATION UPDATE – Miles Nelson presented the water conservation update:
Water Resources Update as of October 5, 2021:
 - As of October 4, 2021, Scofield Reservoir had a water content of 13,243 Acre Feet (20% capacity).
 - Precipitation Accumulation (October 1, 2020 – September 30, 2021) = 18.7” (75% of average).We end the dismal water year (October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021) at 75% of normal precipitation accumulation. Let’s hope for a significant improvement in the coming water year!
