1. Mayor Piccolo called the special workshop to order at 4:45 p.m.
2. Presentation by Lisa Peirce and Sundays Hunt with the Humane Society of Utah regarding proposed changes to the Price City Code involving animal control issues.

Lisa Peirce presented information regarding animal control issues and Price City's animal control ordinance. She thinks the ordinance Price City uses for animal control may be inadequate.

Sundays Hunt, Utah State Director of the Humane Society of the United States, addressed the Mayor and Council. She is available for consultation and coordination of efforts regarding Price City's animal control ordinance. She stated that the Lawrence, Kansas animal control ordinance, a copy of which was previously provided to the Mayor and Council by Ms. Peirce, may be a good example to follow should Price City choose to amend any of its ordinances.

Nick Sampinos, City Attorney, asked Ms. Hunt if she had specific objections, and why, to any specific part of Price City's animal control ordinance. She said no. Mr. Sampinos suggested that Ms. Hunt send a specific list of suggested changes to Price City's animal control ordinance. The suggested changes should be identified by specific section. Any submitted request for change will be reviewed, presented to Council for consideration, and Ms. Hunt will be notified of the outcome. Ms. Hunt will provide the Mayor and Council suggestions for possible updates to the Price City ordinance before the Thanksgiving holiday.

Mayor Piccolo adjourned the City Council special workshop meeting at 5:21 p.m.
