Mayor Piccolo called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and Boy Scout Bonham Brewer led the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll was called with the above Councilmembers and staff in attendance.

1. PUBLIC COMMENT-

John Daniels, Price City Human Resource Director, presented the Water Treatment Manager, Ron Brewer, with a certificate of recognition and gift for 25 years of dedicated employment with Price City. The Mayor and City Council thanked Mr. Brewer for all of his hard work and dedication to the City and maintaining the City's water supply.

2. COUNCILMEMBERS REPORT -The Councilmembers presented an update on the activities and functions in which they have participated.

3. SCHOLARSHIP-Educational scholarship application by Tandy Thackeray-consideration and possible approval of educational scholarship to attend USU-Eastern.

Tandy Thackeray stated that she is from California, playing basketball and working on her Physical Education Degree from USU Eastern. She stated that she plans to use the scholarship from Price City to continue her education and become a Teacher/Coach.
