Targeted to health and safety, such as roofing, broken windows, furnaces, ADA modifications such as walk-in showers and ramps, also, hot water heaters, septic clean out, sewer line repair, minor plumbing, minor electrical, etc. Projects are leveraged with 3 separate program sources to reach as many households and their individual needs, as possible. This program is made available to enable the elderly, disabled and income limited families with children under the age of 10, to remain in their homes under safe and sanitary conditions.

Offers a unique relationship-based strategy that engages the entire community to move from a focus on the management of poverty to collaborative ownership of the solution to poverty. Works on both the individual and community level to empower motivated low-income participants to permanently move out of poverty and into stability.

USDA Self Help Acquisition/Rehab Program 613-0026

Offers financing for the purchase and rehabilitation of a home to income qualified families. The home-buyers provide the labor earning sweat equity for the renovations, and the loan provides the funds for the materials to complete the project. The loans are amortized over a 33-38 year period and subsidy may be available depending on income, allowing the home-buyer to qualify for a home.
