PRICE CITY STATEMENT ON SUPPORT OF PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS

The increasing counts we are experiencing in Utah are deeply concerning—especially since the pandemic is now hitting close to home here in Price. As Mayor and City Council, community safety and health must be our priority. We are urging the citizens of Price to comply with established public health orders which require masks to be worn in high transmission areas (public spaces) and limit social gatherings to 10 people.

We expect Price to come together, as we always do, to support each other whenever any one of us is under duress. Events can always be delayed or rescheduled, wearing masks can be inconvenient and uncomfortable, but, compared to the possibility of losing people within our community, these are the responsible actions to protect each other.

Again, we urge each of you to take precautions to protect not only you and your family's health, but the health of those you encounter in your day-to-day activities. Let's also help protect the well-being of our healthcare workers and our healthcare system, which are being asked to deal with the pandemic as well as provide other critical care services. We appreciate all their efforts. Please remember, while some people may have the ability to overcome the virus, other individuals may not be as fortunate.
