Once an individual or group decides they want to help they will need to contact the City. Price City will supply trash bags, vinyl gloves, volunteers vests (quantity and sizes vary) and landscape maintenance hand tools (e.g. rakes, shovels, hand clippers, brooms etc.).

Community Clean-Up Program Guidelines

Thank you for your participation in the Community Clean-Up Program! Below are some guidelines and information on what to expect at your clean-up. Please follow the guidelines to avoid injury or distress when participating in the clean-ups.

Clean-Up Expectations:

- Interested participants must pre-register to help City Staff gauge how much supplies are needed.
- The City will require an individual of the clean-up group to be the Volunteer Leader who will coordinate and oversee the clean-up event.
- The Volunteer Leader will be responsible to pick up and return all unused trash bags & vinyl gloves along with volunteer vests and maintenance landscape tools to the same location of pickup (Price City Public Works – Domes 432 West 600 South – Price, Utah).
- The Volunteer Leader will be responsible to inform and supply all volunteers for the clean-up event with the Community Clean-Up Program Guidelines.

During the Clean-Up:

- All clean-ups are led and staffed by the Volunteer Leader. City staff are not typically present at the event.
- Follow all safety guidelines listed below.

After the Clean-Up:

- Pile/bag trash at the scheduled clean-up site location and City Staff will pick-up all trash after the clean-up event.
- Drop off any borrowed supplies.
- Report any bulky or hazardous materials to the Volunteer Leader who in turn will report items to the City Staff to dispose of the materials properly.

Safety Guidelines:

1. Volunteers should wear gloves when picking up trash.
2. Volunteers should wear closed-toe shoes (no flip-flops or bare feet) at all times, wear bright clothing or volunteer vests for increased visibility, and sun-block to protect from the sun.
3. Volunteers should never pick-up syringes, needles, or any hazardous objects. Mark the area and notify the Volunteer Leader of the hazardous item's location. The Volunteer Leader will contact the responsible authorities (Carbon County Dispatch (435) 637-0890) to dispose the materials properly.
4. Avoid over-exertion, sunburn, heat exhaustion and dehydration. Bring and drink water.
5. All minors will need to be supervised by at least one (1) responsible adult or guardian.
6. Volunteers should not lift anything too heavy, such as bulky items. Always notify the Volunteer Leader of this type of debris for further assistance.
7. If a volunteer encounters a homeless encampment or property of a homeless person, please refrain from moving anything from the site and clean-up elsewhere.

8. All volunteers are required to stay in the public right-of-way for clean-ups. Please avoid any fenced off areas due to safety and trespassing guidelines.

READ CAREFULLY

I understand that participating in the Community Clean-Up Program event is my choice and is not part, or nor does it arise out of my employment. Participation could possibly result in damage to my personal property and injury to me, including serious and disabling injuries, and even death. Some of these risks may result from underlying medical conditions, limitations, or illnesses which I may have. I hereby agree to assume all the risks arising from my participation and that I, my successors, heirs, guardians, executors, legal representative and assigns will not make any claim against, sue or attach anyone involved in the event, for injury or damage, however caused, as a result of my participation in the Community Clean-Up Program event.
