

RESOLUTION 2011-20

A RESOLUTION CANCELING THE PRICE CITY GENERAL ELECTION ON
NOVEMBER 8, 2011.

WHEREAS, Price City scheduled a General Election on November 8, 2011 to elect three (3) Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, there are three (3) candidates for the three open positions on the Price City Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 20A-1-206, Utah Code Annotated, 1953 as amended (UCA), specifically provides, in pertinent part, that a municipal legislative body may cancel a local election if the number of municipal officer candidates, including any eligible write-in candidates, for the at-large municipal offices does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices for which the candidates have filed; and

WHEREAS, also according to said Section 20A-1-206(c), UCA, the municipal legislative body that cancels a local election must pass, no later than 20 days before the day of the scheduled Election, a resolution that cancels the election and certifies that: each municipal officer candidate is unopposed or the number of candidates does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved as follows:

1. That three (3) persons have filed as candidates for the position of Price City Councilmember.
2. That there are three (3) open positions on the Price City Council for the term beginning January 1, 2012.
3. That the municipal officer candidates for the position of Price City Councilmembers does not exceed the number of open at-large positions on the Price City Council.
4. That the Price City General Election scheduled on November 8, 2011, be and hereby is cancelled.
5. That the City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to publish the cancelled General Election on the Utah State Website, the City's public website, and twice in the *Sun Advocate*, a newspaper of general circulation, before the date of the scheduled election.


