<i>J. nigra</i>	black walnut
<i>J. regia</i>	English or Persian walnut
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i>	sweetgum
<i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i>	tulip tree
<i>Magnolia acuminata</i>	cucumbertree, cucumber magnolia
<i>Morus alba</i>	white mulberry (fruitless only)
<i>M. rubra</i>	red mulberry (fruitless only)
<i>Platanus x acerifolia</i>	London planetree
<i>Quercus acutissima</i>	sawtooth oak
<i>Q. alba</i>	white oak
<i>Q. bicolor</i>	swamp white oak
<i>Q. cerris</i>	turkey oak
<i>Q. imbricaria</i>	shingle or laurel oak
<i>Q. macrocarpa</i>	bur or mossycup oak
<i>Q. muehlenbergii</i>	chinkapin oak
<i>Q. robur</i>	English oak

Q. rubra	northern red oak
Q. shumardii	Shumard oak
Tilia americana	American basswood, American linden
T. x euchlora	Crimean linden
T. tomentosa	silver linden
Ulmus parvifolia	lacebark or Chinese elm (not the same as Siberian elm)
Zelkova serrata	Japanese zelkova
