



TREE/PLANT REMOVAL NOTICE

Cemetery grounds are sacredly devoted to the interment and repose of the deceased. Price City has established rules for the planting of trees and other plants within the city cemeteries. These rules support the City in meeting its legal obligation of perpetual care for all grave sites in the cemetery. The commitment of perpetual care not only includes maintaining each grave site in good order and appearance, but also maintaining a safe environment for all who come to the cemetery. When unauthorized items such as fences, borders, or live trees/shrubs are placed around the grave lot, it prevents the cemetery staff from fulfilling their responsibility of maintaining the cemetery grounds at a level deserving of all who are buried there. In addition, as unauthorized trees or plants grow over time, they also have the potential to damage adjacent headstones, roads, irrigation systems, etc.

With the exception of special permission from the Cemetery Supervisor, the planting of live trees or plants within the cemetery are prohibited. If trees or other live plants have been planted on a grave space without obtaining permission from the Cemetery Supervisor, they are subject to removal. You are receiving this notice because we have no record of permission for planting being granted by the Cemetery Supervisor.

Any such trees or plants remaining after **April 1, 2018** will be subject to removal by Cemetery staff.
